Do you have any language skills that are relevant to specific contexts?* \*Examples concentrations within social impact opportunities can include *Public Health, Education, Linguistics/Language Acquisition, Social Entrepreneurship/Innovation, Environmental Justice, Disability Advocacy, Refugees/Migration, Human Rights*, etc.

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 Participation in Global Scholars requires that you enroll in two special one credit hour Global Scholars courses: Global Scholars Theory Course during the spring semester and Global Scholars Reflection Course (INS 3005) during the fall semester following your summer experience. **The spring theory classes will be held on Fridays from 3:05-4:20pm, and the fall class will be most-likely held on Friday afternoons, from 3-5pm. You will need to be enrolled in these courses.** Additionally, during your summer experience and in preparation for the fall reflection course, you will be required to complete blogs, a capstone project related to your experience; and as a part of the Fall course, you will prepare and present your capstone at the Global Scholars Showcase. You will be automatically enrolled in the FSU courses by CRE staff upon confirmation of acceptance into the program by December 15th.
