

Housing Affordability in Leon County, Florida

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Question

In what ways do changes in income, if at all, impact housing consumption?

Background

- Families with housing financial strain experience reduced educational outcomes. 23
- Leon County's single-family home prices rose from \$179,000 to \$349,000 between 2012 and 2023. 41
- The Engel curve treats housing as an inferior good. 30
- The assumption that higher incomes spend less on housing may be challenged if they opt for more expensive housing.³¹

Methods & Model

- 1. Removed outliers and geocoded data to Zip Code Tabulation Areas (ZCTA).
- 2. Calculated sale medians, in square footage terms.
- 3. Data from American Community Survey and appraiser is put into real terms.
- 4. Checked for multicollinearity, ran regressions.
- 5. Evaluated best model fit (linear or exponential).

Limitations

- Square footage is calculated from acreage information rather than square footage information.
- Sale data obtained only from single-family homes.
- Variables for gender ratios, institutional investors, subsidies, and household size were excluded.

Preliminary Results




Figure 2: Sale Price to Household Income Medians Plot



Table 1: Estimating Model Results

Adjusted R Square	0.196
Significance Level (Regression)	< 0.001
Coefficient	\$1,661.16
Lower Bound (95% Confidence)	\$959.70
Upper Bound (95% Confidence)	\$2,362.63

Findings & Implications

- Tallahassee's highest income bracket shows economies of scale parallel to county-wide trends.
- House Price Index and Case Shiller Index should be used to measure housing affordability.
- Streamline zoning regulations for improved housing production.
- To incentivize housing construction, tax unimproved land. 17
- Future research should investigate rental properties.

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
