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Human Intuition vs Artificial Intelligence

Artificial Intelligence (AI) is transforming education, but should it replace human intuition? Our research explores the limits of AI and the irreplaceable role of human intelligence in decision-making, creativity, and emotional connection.

At Florida State University (FSU), we are developing a 24/7 Al assistant chatbot designed to enhance—not replace—human advisors. It provides instant student support, handling routine inquiries while seamlessly escalating complex or sensitive issues to real people.

Rooted in Dr. Etschmaier's Purposeful Systems Framework and the ancestral wisdom of Inka Intuition, this research highlights why AI must remain a tool that serves people, not the other way around. While AI excels at efficiency, it lacks the lived experience, empathy, and moral grounding that define human intuition.
